## *Summer Term: Year 6 Curriculum Letter*

Dear Parents and Carers,

A huge welcome back to the third and final term at Brookfield! We have got lots of great things planned for the next few months and we're sure that the children will enjoy their remaining time at Brookfield.

As you are aware, the Key Stage 2 (KS2) SATs will be taking place in the week beginning **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May**. **We will be holding a meeting for parents/carers regarding SATs Week on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> May at 3:30pm - 3:50pm in Katie's classroom.** The children have been working very hard and we are proud of the effort they are putting into their learning. We will be spending the next couple of weeks focusing on revising the relevant topics that we have already studied. The weekly Home Learning will reflect tasks and concepts covered in class. Please make sure that the children arrive in school on time each day, having had **a good night's sleep and a hearty breakfast** in preparation.

Following the SATs, we have a number of exciting activities and opportunities planned. Our curriculum will be project-based, with the children continuing and extending their Maths and Literacy skills within the context of Geography, History and the Arts. Our topic will be 'London through time', in which we will be learning about how the city has grown and changed from the Iron Age to the present day. Alongside this, we will be looking at key features of the area. Our History lessons will be closely entwined with Geography, as we will be learning about life in key periods of London's history.

Our Art lessons will focus on collage and in DT we will be cooking. Students will learn to make a variety of small dishes, as well as focussing on safe and sanitary preparation of food and good nutrition. Later in the term, we will be producing scenery and props for our Year 6 production.

In Science, along with revision of some previous units, we will learn about 'Evolution and Inheritance' and extend our understanding of 'Light'. Within Science and PSHE, we will move on to learn about SRE (Sex and Relationship Education) and we will be holding a meeting about this for parents and carers beforehand. We will contact you regarding the date.
