Nursery Class Trips and Workshops 2018 - 2019

Dear Nursery Parents and Carers,

As part of our commitment to providing an exciting core offer of trips and workshops for every year group, we will be organising the following activities for your child this year:

Autumn – A shadow puppet show, Lantern Walk, Forest School

Spring – Exotic animal workshop, visit to Kentish Town City Farm, Forest School, Camden learning Centre in-school workshop

Summer – A visit to the National Portrait Gallery for a 'sculpting stories' workshop, trip to the Hampstead Heath paddling pool, FAB collage workshops, Forest School

The total cost of this year's trips and workshops, taking into account travel arrangements will be approximately £650. We are therefore requesting a one off voluntary contribution of **£20** from those parents/carers **who are not in receipt of pupil premium**.

The voluntary contribution can either be paid as a cheque made payable to Brookfield Primary School or paid on-line in the same way you pay for dinner money – simply log on to the school's web-site and follow the link. Please contact Carole in the office if you are a first time user to collect the pupil link code. If you would prefer to pay in installments, then this can also be arranged with the school office. If you would like to donate the full amount for your child's trips and workshops, you would also be most welcome. For anyone wishing to contribute more, we would also be extremely grateful for any extra financial support to offset against the overall costs.

Unfortunately, if you do not complete the permission slip, we will not be able to include your child on the trips.
