Maths: arithmetic + reasoning

Literacy: focus on covering a variety of writing styles; Spelling and Grammar taught daily

Science: Working Scientifically, Electricity, Light, Evolution, Animals, Including Human (Human Body), Living Things and Habitats

History: Second World War (focus on 'Children in Wartime'), London Through Time

Geography: Immigration, Global Citizenship, Fair Trade

RE: Sikhism ('Communities'), Ritual ('Hinduism'), Symbols ('Buddhism')

Art and DT: Textiles, Printing, Painting, Collage, Cooking, Electrical Systems.

Maths

Arithmetic:

(Covers four operations, fractions, percentages)

Assessment 1 paper out of 40

Reasoning:

Problem Solving, Measurement, Conversion of measurement, Shape, Statistics, Number relationships.

Assessment: 2 Papers on reasoning out of 35

Literacy

We cover a range of text types, fiction and non-fiction, through the study of meaningful, engaging texts e.g 'Wonder' 'Boy In The Striped Pyjamas' 'The Garbage King'.

Writing Portfolios:

Beginning Spring Term, children write up their best pieces of work for these portfolios.

Daily Spelling and Grammar practice, which children will be assessed on in a separate paper (SPAG paper)
