<b>Junior Playground Shed</b>	Children and their classes have come up with ideas for things we could put in the Junior playground, including giant construction, soft play and trampolines.	Lucy to discuss with Mark the size and health and safety behind what can go in shed and get back to school council.
<b>Football Cage</b>	Ways to make the football cage a happier environment. There were ideas to create a football charter and also to buy bibs for the football cage so children can tell who is on which team. The children would also like an adult to referee the cage.	Lucy to order bibs with Cee. Children to ask classes for ideas for Football charter. Lucy to discuss with support staff on duty about referee position.
<b>Infant Playground</b>	Children in the infants would like to fill the empty window on their climbing frame. Suggestions of a slide or some kind of art work were made.	Lucy will ask Mark about budget and possibilities for this.
<b>Takeover Day</b>	Children would like to take on different roles again. The idea of adults being more involved this year came up. Teachers to play in the playground at playtime.	Lucy to encourage teachers to go outside for last 10 mins of lunchtime to play with the children.  Publicity officers to launch takeover day in assembly after half term.
<b>Charities</b>	After Christmas we will be choosing the school charity. This should be linked to global warming and tie in with the work our rights ambassadors have been doing.	Class reps to ask their classes for ideas about which charities we could support and why
<b>Other issues</b>	KS1 children addressed issues such as no clock in 1C and not enough bins in the playgrounds.	Children to discuss with Derek about getting a clock for 1C's classroom.
