This week, PE lessons began really successfully with Haseeb and Aaron for children in years 2, 3, 4 and 5. Here are some comments from parents about these sessions:

PE lessons meet in between the tennis courts and Bistro Laz on Hampstead Heath. Times for your bubble class have been re-circulated today.

We are continuing to work with the wider school community to find other creative ways for children, parents and carers to meet up outside of school, safely in their 'satellite bubbles'. In line with government guidance, limiting the size of the group minimises the risk of infection. The names of the children in each group have been listed below and we hope that parents and carers are able to organise further activities. Here are some suggestions:

Waterlow Park:

We would like to organise a time for the children to meet at Waterlow Park for a socially distanced picnic! This will be a chance for them to play with other children in their year group. We are hoping the playground will be opened from the 4th of July. We are unable to provide staff for this, so children must be supervised at all times. Location and your group day and time are being circulated in letters today.

Kentish Town farm:

The farm are open from Monday 29th June to pre booked groups of 6 (which includes adults too). This will give children the opportunity to visit the farm, see the animals and socialise with children from their bubble. If you would like to organise a visit to the farm, please book on their website: www.ktcityfarm.org.uk . Time slots last for 45 minutes and include a short health and

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safety induction. Entrance is free and slots are available from 11-3pm. Please note there are currently no riding sessions.

Woodwork:

The wonderful Ricky and Jess at Highgate Newtown Community Centre are now open for groups of up to five for woodwork classes. Please feel free to organise a woodwork session with children in your bubble class. There are free spaces for children whose families are experiencing financial hardship.
